

New features in Winter '12 release

Below you will find an overview of the most important new or changed features in the Winter '12 release.

Process diagram filter

The process diagram filter in ENGAGE Modeler allows you to show/hide certain process step types or process step types with a specific property in the process diagram. For example: only show the choices and decisions. In that way you have an overview of the decision tree.

Cross reference reports with export to Word and Excel

In ENGAGE Modeler and ENGAGE Viewer you have the possibility to see some pre-defined reports, such as:

- Documents per process;
- Documents per role;
- Roles per process;
- Processes per role.

ENGAGE Tables users who have created one or more extra properties for a process step can also see some reports about these extra properties.

All reports can be exported to Microsoft Word and Excel.

Authorization reports with export to Word and Excel

In addition to the reports mentioned in the previous paragraph there are also reports which gives you an overview per process, model or project of the authorization settings.

Comparison of analysis results

You're now able to compare the results of two processes. Just select the processes you want to compare and an overview pops up with the differences in numbers and percentages.

Tabular property editor

In ENGAGE Modeler you can find a tabular property editor for easy and fast entering properties of process steps.

Input and output for an expanded sub process

There's a small change in how input and output of a sub process is presented to the user. When a sub process is collapsed then you can see the input above and the output below the icon. Now, when you expand the sub process then the input is shown above the begin of the sub process icon and the output below the end of the sub process icon.

Indicate a Break, Choice and Decision as 'Risk point'

Now you can also indicate a break, choice and decision as a risk point in the process diagram.

Feedback-right

In the previous release we've introduced the feedback functionality. In this release this functionality is extended. Instead of turning this functionality on or off for all users and processes you now can specify who is allowed to give feedback for what process.

Automatic locking of an opened project

For ENGAGE Modeler Enterprise users the opened project will immediately be locked for other users. Of course this user should have the right to make changes and the project isn't locked by an other user.

Rename of a model or a process of a linked process

With a 'Process link' you can refer to another process. In this release this link is smarter. Now, when you rename the model and/or the process of the linked process the properties of the process link are changed too. In other words, the link stays and is not broken as it was before.
